## White wine

**WEISSBURGUNDER** - The Pinot blanc is an internationally widespread variety and the youngest member of the Pinot family. It is recognisable from its delicate, often restrained bouquet and its soft acidity, that often makes it an ideal blending partner with other white Pinot varieties. The white grape variety originates from France. Young wines have a blossomy expression and piquant acidity, while mature versions tend to develop bread and nut flavours. Maturation goes slowly and the highest quality is achieved after longer bottle ageing.

**CHARDONNAY** - Chardonnay is genetically related to the Burgundy Pinot varieties. In the 1980s, it experienced a tremendous upswing in popularity in Alto Adige, and it continues to demonstrate its classic qualities in the province. It is captivating through its fine acidity and its elegant interplay of aromas of pineapple, bananas, apples, pears, citrus fruit, caramel, vanilla, and butter. Its palette can range from the fresh, fruity, linear qualities of the versions that are stabilized in stainless steel tanks to the complex selections suitable for aging which are fermented right in the small oak casks and allowed to mature on fine yeast.

**PINOT GRIGIO** - This originates from the large family of Burgundy Pinot grapes and is regarded as one of the most noble white wines of all. Pinot Gris is a full-bodied, extract-rich white wine with a warm, flowery scent which demonstrates different characteristics depending upon its zone of cultivation. When harvested very early, the wines become light and sparkling. As it is prone to Botrytis – which develops to noble rot when it appears later in the season – the Pinot Gris often shows a strong palate characterized by the Botrytis with a typical honey tone. Achieves high quality as an aged wine.

**SAUVIGNON** - Sauvignon Blanc is a global player. This variety has a characteristic bouquet, which can be intrusively unripe and grassy when the grapes are not fully ripe. When the grapes have good ripeness, they develop complex aromas of black currants, gooseberries and tropical fruit. Depending on the degree of maturity, the wines develop from subtle to very complex, which in combination with barrique ageing and biological acid reduction have great development potential.

**SYLVANER** - In Alto Adige, Sylvaner (Silvaner) is planted almost exclusively in the Isarco Valley, the gateway to the Dolomites, where it primarily appreciates the cool terraced slopes from 500 to 700 m. (1,600 to 2,300 ft.) which are nevertheless bathed in sunshine. At these elevations, the variety develops both sufficient body and a robust acidity. An earthy, mineral scent is typical of Sylvaner, accompanied by aromas of fresh herbs or hay.

**MÜLLER THURGAU** - Named after the Swiss vine researcher Hermann Müller who came from Thurgau, this hybrid crossing of Riesling and Madeleine Royale that has achieved worldwide success produces especially lively, aromatic white wines. Along with its typical aroma of nutmeg, in the Isarco Valley the grape produces a scent of elder blossoms, in the warmer Bassa Atesina we find tones of nuts and stone fruits, while in the Val Venosta, mineral tones and a slight scent of apple prevail.

**KERNER** - Thanks to its resistance to frost, the German hybrid of Trollinger and Riesling, named after the Swabian poet Justinus Kerner, is planted primarily at the higher elevations of the Isarco Valley and the Val Venosta in the Italian Alps. This grape produces sleek, spicy Italian white wines with a slight hint of nutmeg. Thanks to its rich abundance of aroma and its fine, fruity bouquet, Kerner has the potential to become a new point of pride for Alto Adige's winegrowers.

**GRÜNER VELTLINER** - is Austria's flagship variety, planted in more than one third of the country's vineyards. The areas where Veltliner is most widely-planted are located in the state of Niederösterreich and around Vienna. These wines tend to show fruity-spicy notes, with a dash of „Pfefferl“ –freshly ground black pepper – included. Grüner Veltliner expresses itself wonderfully according to the soils in which it is grown: racy and powerful from loess; delicately spicy and mineral-toned from primary rock. And from loamy clay soils, it demonstrates a robust character.

**RIESLING** - To connoisseurs, Riesling was - and still is - the most noble of all white wine varieties. Its fine aromatic character is highlighted – without imposing special cellar techniques – simply through vinification in steel tanks or large wooden barrels. The wines are highly elegant and possess outstanding storage potential. It is a variety that is unsuitable for barrique aging, because the potent oak would veil the wonderful Riesling fruitiness. Equally impressive about this variety: it is able to carry from vineyard to bottle the character of the terroir. The wines are medium- to full-bodied, have enormous depth and display an impressive range of fruit tones: apricot, peach and exotic fruit combined with fine mineral notes.

**GEWÜRZTRAMINER** - As the name already reveals, Gewürztraminer originated in the Alto Adige winegrowing village of Tramin. Its sumptuous spectrum of scents, with notes of rose petals, cloves, lychees, and other tropical fruits, makes Gewürztraminer the absolute embodiment of an aromatic wine variety. With its intense color, comparatively high alcohol content, and luxuriant texture, it is the epitome of a meditation wine.

# Red wine

**VERNATSCH** - The original name of this autochthonous grape variety was Farnatzer or Vernetzer. Its first documented historical mention dates back to the end of the Middle Ages. The Schiava grape, known in German as Vernatsch, produces a light wine that is low in tannins, with a moderate alcohol content and individual character that is typical to the zone. For example, the St. Magdalener (Santa Maddalena) is regarded fuller in body, the Kalterersee (Lago di Caldaro) is softer, and the Meraner (Meranese) is somewhat spicy

**ZWIEGELT** - Zweigelt is a grape variety that finds its ideal cultivation area at medium altitudes. This is why it has gained a leading position among the varieties typically grown in South Tyrol. The Wine is obtained from selected and fully ripe Zweigelt grapes, fermented in stainless steel tanks and aged in wooden barrels. It is fermented and aged in steel vats so that the resulting wine proves fresh, fruity and youthful. Its garnet red colour is full of light and recalls the delicate fragrance of cherries and wild berries. To the palate it is fresh and full of mineral nuances, combined with smooth and pleasant notes of tannin and of light acidity.

**BLAUBURGUNDER** - Pinot Noir grapes are grown around the world, mostly in the cooler climates of Europe, such as Switzerland, Alto Adige in Northern Italy, Germany and Austria. Other regions that have gained a reputation for Pinot Noir are located in Oregon, California, South Africa, South Australia and New Zealand. Pinot Noir is the primary varietal used in sparkling wine production in Champagne and other wine regions. Pinot Noir from optimal vineyard sites, with high ripeness, and through skilled vinification, can deliver high quality wines with good ageability - even despite that it is sensitive and a challenge to the winemaker in the vineyard and the cellar. Characteristically, it does not have a very dark colour. Its typical aroma is discreet with notes from red berries (strawberry, raspberry, morello cherry), forest soil and dried plums.

**LAGREIN** - Lagrein is an autochthonous wine filled with character. Its origins are deeply rooted in the provincial capital of Bolzano, and it has recently experienced a genuine renaissance. Lagrein is impressive with its aromas of berries, fresh cherries, and violets. On the palate, it demonstrates a velvety body and soft acidity. After aging in small oak casks, tones of spice lend additional charm and character to the top selections. A rosé version of the grape is also made, known as “Lagrein Kretzer” (or “Lagrein Rosato”).

**MERLOT** - Merlot was first planted in Alto Adige along with other Bordeaux varieties around 120 years ago. This early-ripening variety is planted primarily in warm locations on deep, chalky soils. It yields fruity, full-bodied wines with a southern charm and soft, ripe tannins.

**CABERNET** - As a young wine, it is fruity and somewhat “rough-edged” with strong tannins and a powerful bouquet. As a late-ripening variety, it must be planted in warm sites, otherwise the wines will likely show a grassy character. The wines need a longer development time so that the tannins can ripen. Maturing in barriques is practically obligatory – it complements the variety perfectly.

**SYRAH** - Is a high-quality red grape variety and is considered to be the oldest noble grape in the world. The vine, which is proven to be a cross between the French varieties Dureza and Mondeuse, originated in the French Rhone Valley. The grapes are blue-black in colour, have soft flesh and a pleasant aroma of raspberries and violets. Syrah wines are tannin-rich, ageable red wines of outstanding quality

**SANGIOVESE** - is a red wine variety originating from Italy. It is one of the most important and common grape varieties there and forms the basis for well-known wines such as Brunello di Montalcino, Chianti Classico, Chianti, Morellino di Scansano or Vino Nobile di Montepulciano. In general, a Sangiovese wine is characterised by a rather light red colour and a pronounced structure with a high acid and tannin content.
